This skit (dirge) had everyone rolling out of their seats with laughter.

The frog fun continued throughout the year. LeRoy Morford, also from Marshalltown, made up frog plaques, frog cards and many other frog paraphernalia to help Optimism grow for his Club. He enjoyed the theme so much he decided to be my Lt. Governor for the Zone even though he was still the President of his Club. LeRoy, later, at the International Convention in New Orleans, took a costume of a frog, which his wife Patti created, and walked, around the hall promoting the Iowa District and Optimism. He also included the JOOI Convention with his antics.

The Presidents Visit was another huge highlight. Yves Berthiaume came to Iowa in April of 2005. His request was, he wanted to do something as a community service project in the community. I selected the Ronald McDonald House in Iowa City for a service project where we cleaned, vacuumed, and straightened the proper area of the house and raked leaves and collected trash outside on the grounds. Then, we baked and decorated cookies for the residents. We, later, visited the children's Oncology unit at the University of Iowa Children's Hospital. This was a sad occasion but one that lifted Yves' heart and was very much appreciated by him. The evening was filled with awards and a fabulous meal at the Little Amana's to celebrate Immediate Past Governor, Dale Robertson's Year. Yves was presented with a huge, hand-carved, (by Ken Walton) wooden spoon with the Iowa Logo on the top part of the spoon handle.

The International Convention was held in New Orleans, Louisiana. The weather was untypical for this area and not near as hot as expected. There were nearly 40 Iowans attending. The Opening session was in true Mardi Gras fashion and the Presidents Ball was just as glamorous with Mardi Gras caricatures ornamenting the room. We came into New Orleans greeted by Hurricane Cindy and we were the last flight off the tarmac as air flights were closing due to the arrival of Hurricane Dennis. Later, in August, was the Arrival of the most damaging Hurricane New Orleans ever experienced; Hurricane Katrina which ripped the life from New Orleans and caused the levees to break around Lake Ponchartrain, which caused the evacuation of the entire city and was nearly the death of New Orleans.

I was with positive membership throughout my entire year, practically. Iowa District finished the year with a net plus two. A net plus one was required to become a Distinguished District. We finished at 13<sup>th</sup> place out of the 57 Districts and our Region was 1<sup>st</sup> place winner for that year.

I will never forget this experience and I will never forget those who were a huge part of Iowa's success in becoming a Distinguished District. I chose "Leaping Above Expectations" because I knew I had to do just that to succeed.

My dream of becoming a Governor is now past but the realization of that dream lives on through the history of the Great Iowa District.
